### **NEW GRAND PIANO**

The MHCC Foundation approved the purchase of a new grand piano for the Music department. MHCC music instructors Dan Davey and Kevin Lambert worked with Classic Pianos of Portland to purchase a new grand for a significantly discounted price of \$51,500. Davey had this to say about the new piano: "Thanks to the support of the college, the Foundation and Dr. Derr, we were able to purchase this beautiful 7'6" Yamaha C7X from Classic Pianos to replace the Baldwin concert grand piano that MHCC purchased in the 70s. We were also able to replace all of the tired upright pianos in our practice and ensemble rooms with brand new Yamaha pianos! This drastically improves the day-to-day operation of our department and gives our students the opportunity to perform and practice on worldclass pianos."

# PEAK PERFORMER

### **DAVID CRESS**

MT. HOOD COMMUNITY COLLEGE, **CLASS OF 1992** 

### TELEVISION AND FILM PRODUCER, "PORTLANDIA," "PARANOID PARK"

David Cress knew for a long time that he wanted to work in filmmaking. In the 1980s, when he was just beginning to explore his job options, he was unsure whether he could make a career for himself in his native Portland and so far from the established Hollywood entertainment industry. He persisted though and sought a program where he could study television and film, which led him to Mt. Hood Community College.

Enrolling in MHCC's television production and cable and community television program, he began developing the educational foundation that he still relies on today in his career as a producer of film, television and commercials. However, it was the instructors at MHCC that really helped Cress build his confidence and gain a foothold in the industry.

"I especially appreciate Jack Schommer; he and the other instructors were patient and immensely helpful," said Cress. "I use something that Jack taught me almost every day of my professional career, and it was he that pushed me to find a local internship, which helped launch my career." David's advice for filmography students: "Persist. It's not an easy career to get off the ground, but my experience is that if you work at it and hang around long enough, odds are it will happen for you."



Cress with MHCC President Dr. Debbie Derr: "MHCC offered one of only two programs in the area at the time," said Cress, "and it turned out to be a great move for me."

# MHCC FOUNDATION PROVIDES \$300,000 FOR NEW MECHATRONICS PROGRAM

The 300,000 donated to start the Mechatronics program represents the foundation's largest individual gift ever to an academic program. Mechatronics is an emerging, in-demand field that combines electrical and mechanical engineering, computer technologies and manufacturing maintenance.

"This donation sets the stage for what we hope will be the top college program in the region for industrial maintenance and automation," said Jarrod Hogue, MHCC's associate VP of Workforce, Innovation and Partnerships. "Coupled with resources form the Oregon Talent Council grant, these funds allow MHCC to expand and accelerate our path towards becoming one of the first certification centers for industrial robots in the Northwest."

Nearly half of the initial \$300,000 will be used to purchase smaller, educational versions of robotic arms commonly used in manufacturing facilities throughout the world. Students will learn to program these arms to accomplish various tasks and advanced automation, and be able to become certified in their use. Another large chunk of the funding will be used to purchase eight Amatrol Trainers. The trainers are self-contained workstations that recreate the industrial environment and simulate various manufacturing and engineering processes. This allows for a safe hands-on learning environment on equipment that is industry standard



In addition to the initial gift, the Foundation has also established a Mechatronics Scholarship and has partially funded a Mechatronics faculty position. "This investment will help create an exciting opportunity for so many future students" said MHCC Foundation Board President Angela McKenzie-Tucker.

# LEAVING A LEGACY

The Foundation funds for the Mechatronics Program were provided by the Marvin and Jean Allen Charitable Remainder Trust (CRT). Jean and Marvin Allen created the trust as a financial tool that allowed them to convert a highly appreciated asset and receive lifetime income. Charitable Remainder Trusts can reduce income taxes now and estate taxes later. The Allens also had the satisfaction of knowing that they would be benefiting future generations of MHCC students.


